**Lifeguard** — Must be at least **16 years of age** at the time of hire. Lifeguards are responsible for the safety and well being of all patrons at the Gonzales Community Pool. Responsibilities include but are not limited to; teaching swim lessons, direct pool supervision, administering CPR/First Aid/AED in the event of an emergency, participate in opening and closing procedures, assist in cleaning of the facility, assist in registration for pool activities, consistently enforcing all pool and facility rules and other duties as assigned. IF HIRED YOU MUST PARTICIPATE IN ALL SWIM LESSON CERTIFICATION TRAININGS AS SCHEDULED.

Hours vary between 20 - 40 hours per week.

The City of Gonzales may pay for Lifeguard Certifications if the following conditions are met:

- 1. You are a resident of the City of Gonzales
- 2. You have a successful interview and are recommended for a physical ability assessment
- 3. Pass the Physical Ability Assessment which consists of a 300m swim, dive to a 12 ft depth to retrieve a 10lb brick and return it back kicking to the shallow end and 2 minute tread water with hands up.
- 4. Attend and successfully complete the Lifeguard Certification Course as scheduled by the City of Gonzales
- 5. Agree to work for the City of Gonzales Aquatics Department for at least 1 summer

**Swim Instructor**— Must be at least **15 1/2 years of age** by the date of hire. Responsibilities include but are not limited to; teaching children to swim, knowing the swim curriculum as provided by the facility, preparation and clean up for each level of swim lessons, assisting Lifeguards in the event of an emergency, participate in opening and closing procedures, assist in cleaning of the facility and other duties as assigned. IF HIRED YOU MUST PARTICIPATE IN ALL SWIM LESSON CERTIFICATION TRAININGS AS SCHEDULED.

Hours vary between 15 - 30 hours per week.

**Pool Recreation Aid 1** — Must be at least **15 1/2 years of age** by the date of hire. Responsibilities include but are not limited to; Stocking, cleaning and running the snack bar, working the front gate, assisting Lifeguards in the event of an emergency, participate in opening and closing procedures, assist in cleaning of the facility, assist in registration for pool activities, consistently enforcing all pool and facility rules, answering phones, meeting the needs of pool patrons and other duties as assigned

Hours vary between 15 - 25 hours per week.

**Summer Camp Counselor** — Must be at least **16 years of age** by the date of hire. Responsibilities include but are not limited to; supervising groups of 8-10 youth between the ages of 5 and 12, Creating and implementing activities that keep the children engaged, swimming, singing, dancing, acting silly, being creative, all while enforcing the camp rules and maintaining a safe environment for all participants, and other duties as assigned.
