Trainings: May 21, 2019 6:00 - 9:30PM (This training is Mandatory) **Parents must attend from 6:00 - 6:30PM**

Day Camp :

Under the direction of the Camp Director and an assigned Camp Counselor, assist with daily activities for children ages 5-12. Activities will include; sports activities, arts & crafts, swimming, field trips, park play, group games, singing, skits and more !

Time Requirements: Weekdays, Daily, either Part time (4 Hours AM or PM) or Full Time (8 Hours with a lunch break). Must commit to at least 4 weeks In order to maintain consistency with the children, you must commit to the whole week if you choose to work that week.

Pool Employment Experience:

Under the direction of the Pool Manager and Assistant manager, participants will learn about pool maintenance, assist with swimming lessons, assist with Tot Swim and recreation swim. Interns may opt in to the Junior Lifeguard Program based on swimming skill level. Junior Lifeguard participants will train for the Lifeguard Entry Swim Assessment.

Time Requirements: 10 hours per week as scheduled.

Drama Employment Experience: (This program has not been confirmed)

Under the direction of the Drama Program Directors, interns will assist with the Summer Theatre program. Interns will assist with technical aspects such as sets, costumes, lights and sound. Drama program Interns will be required to participate for the length of the program,

Time Requirements: Monday thru Thursday for 5 weeks.

Sports Employment Experience:

Under the direction of the Sports Coordinator, interns will assist with youth and adult sports. Interns will assist with score keeping, equipment maintenance, field preparations, snack bar, and may help with officiating youth sports.

Time Requirements: Evenings and Weekends as scheduled
