SAFTEY RULES AND GUIDELINES

PARADE WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 12PM ON SUNDAY, JULY 4th, 2021!

- The parade will start at the Taylor Farms Family Health & Wellness Center parking lot located at 850 5th Street. Entrants should arrive in the parking lot by 11:00am.
- 2. Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation of these rules.
- 3. No political signage is permitted on an entry.
- 4. No flyers, pamphlets, or handouts are permitted.
- 5. Student/Youth floats must have adults present.
- 6. All floats must carry a fire extinguisher.
- 7. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the parade route.
- 8. Any entry of a live animal(s) should have a person assigned "pooper scooper" duties.
- 9. All motor vehicle entries should have working tail lights.
- 10. Motor vehicle drivers should maintain at least a 50 foot following distance with the next entry.
- 11. Flatbed trucks and pickup trucks should ensure proper safety for individuals riding on the flatbed or in bed of truck, including providing seats and/or handholds for standing passengers.
- 12. Your entry may not leave the parade route before the end of the parade.
- 13. <u>Throwing of candy, beads, or novelty items to parade watchers is not allowed</u>. Handing out said items may be done within the side walk areas away from the parade route itself.
- 14. Musical/Entertainment entries are encouraged to perform along the parade route as long as performance does not bring the parade to a standstill. These entries are permitted and encouraged to stop to perform in front of the judge's platform. This performance should not exceed one minute so as not to prolong the parade.
- 15. You also agree to release all liability from the Gonzales Chamber of Commerce/Rotary Club of Gonzales/City of Gonzales/Gonzales Unified School District/Lions Club of Gonzales from accident of injury real or imagined.
