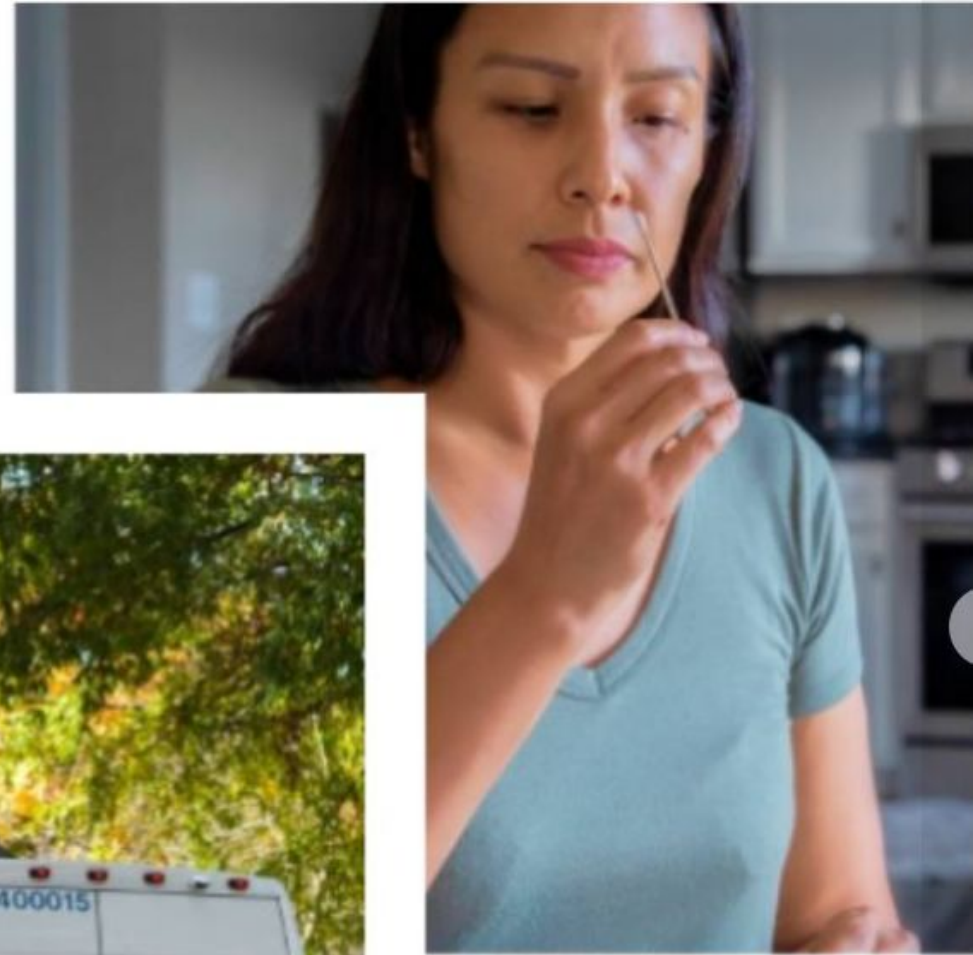

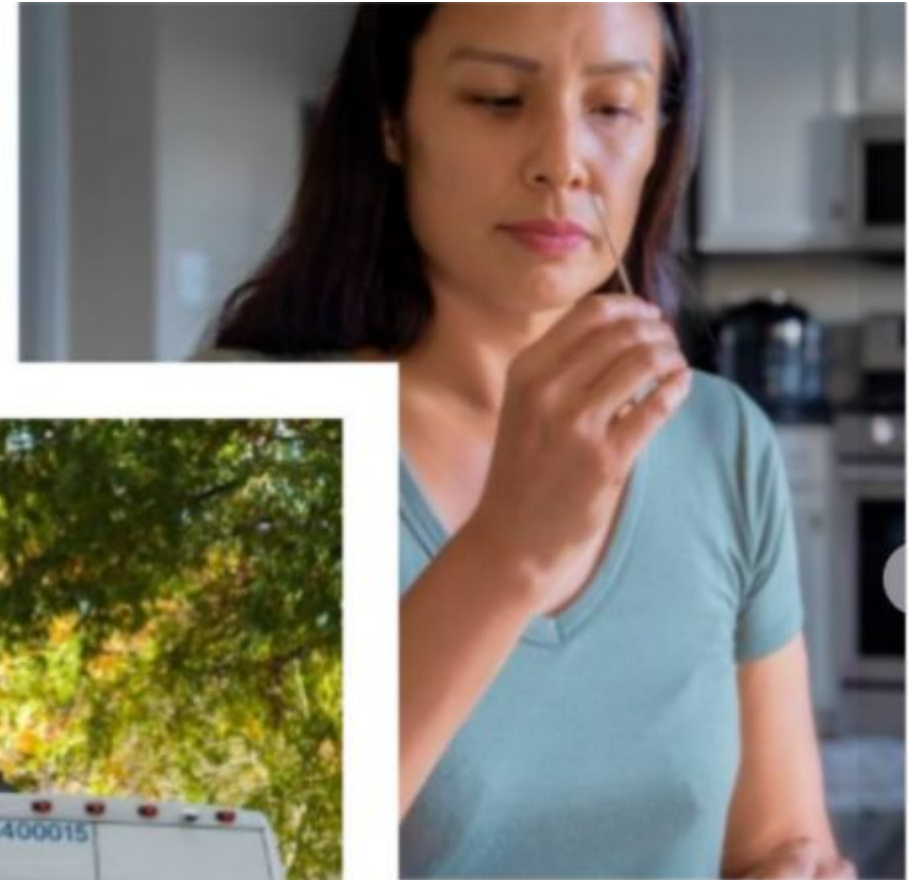

THE COVID-19 TEST I TOOK AT HOME CAME BACK POSITIVE. WHAT SHOULD I DO NOW?



Most people have mild symptoms and get better at home.

**At-home antigen tests work.
You don't need to take a PCR test.**

HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO:



- 1 Stay home and isolate from others.** If you can, stay in a room away from others.
- 2 Take care of yourself.** Get plenty of rest. Keep track of your symptoms.
- 3 Get medical help right away if:**
 - You have a hard time breathing.
 - You have chest pain.
 - You feel confused or hazy.
 - You can't stay awake.
- 4 Call your doctor or health center.** Reach out if you have questions, are seeking advice, or have concerns.
- 5 Tell people you spend time with that you tested positive.** If someone was near you for 15 minutes or more, they should test 5 days after. Stay away from others until you test negative.

 - No puede permanecer despierto.
- 4** **Llame a su doctor o centro de salud.** Comuníquese si tiene preguntas, está buscando consejo o tiene inquietudes.
- 5** **Déjele saber a las personas con las que pasa tiempo que su prueba salió positiva.** Si alguien estuvo cerca de usted durante 15 minutos o más, debe hacerse la prueba 5 días después. Manténgase alejado de los demás hasta que su prueba salga negativa.

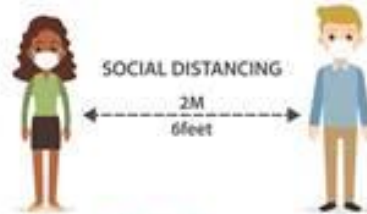

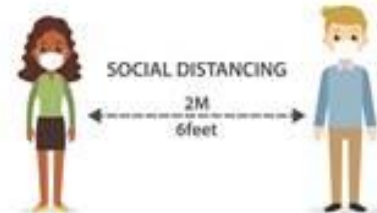

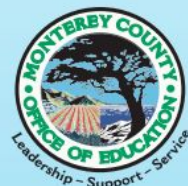
