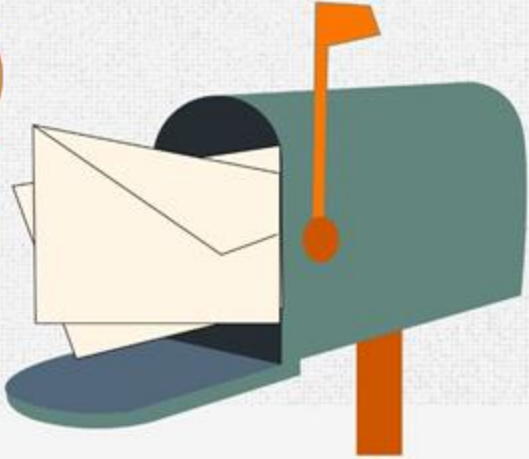

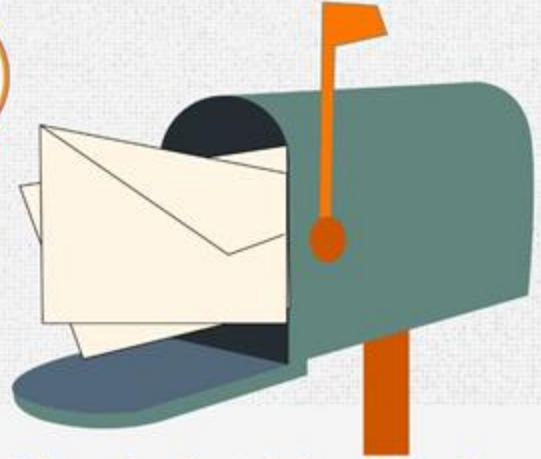

SSRC

Silver Star Resource Center (SSRC) is a multi-agency collaborative of prevention and early intervention services designed to promote positive youth developments by reducing risk factors that lead to gang involvement and delinquency of youth in Monterey County ages 6-21. The collaborative provides a "ONE-STOP" location of caring connection for youth and family services. SSRC employs an innovative, multi-agency approach that combines probation supervision, educational, vocational and job training, counseling and mediation services, anger management, truancy abatement, mentoring outreach to the community, substance abuse programs, a family support service to at-risk or gang involved youth.

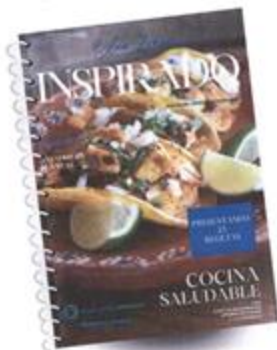

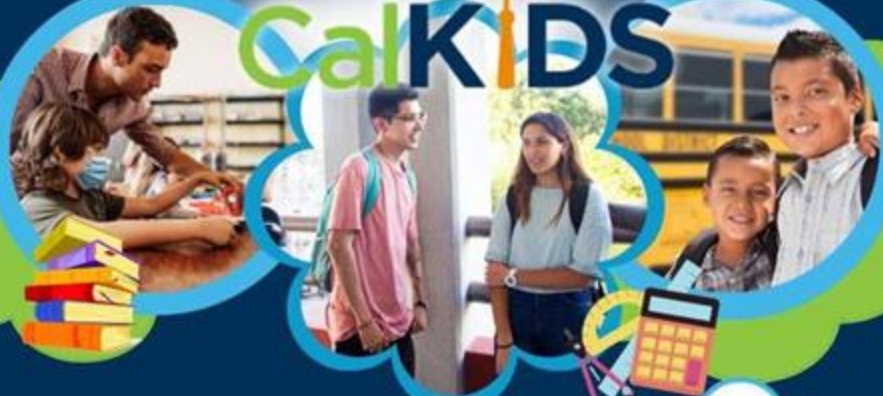

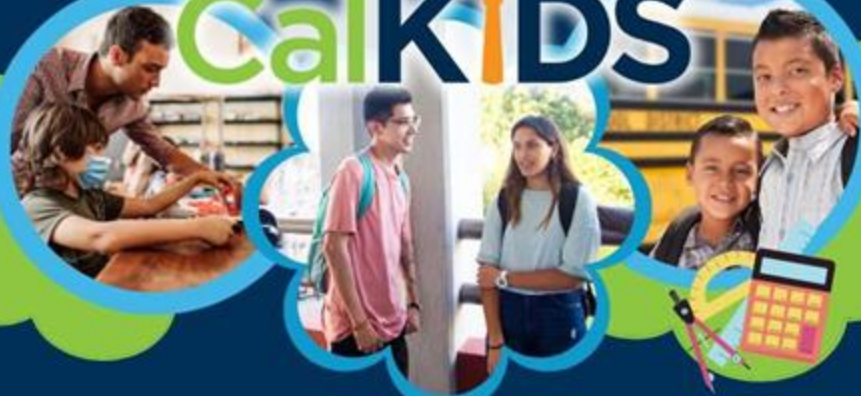

VISTA LUCIA COMMUNITY

Vista Lucia is a planned community being proposed in Gonzales, Ca. on the north-east side of town, off Fanoe Rd.

The Community includes 768 acres with 3,498 residential units of all sizes and affordability levels. It will take years to reach full build out with the first phase of the project comprising 400 homes.

The developer and city are hoping that construction on the project will start in Spring of 2026.



The Vista Lucia Community will include various types of housing, including Apartments, Townhomes, and Single-Family Units. It will also include New Schools, Large Parks and Open Space, a Fire Station, New Parkways and Trails and New Commercial Areas.

Vista Lucia es una comunidad planeada que se está proponiendo en Gonzales, Ca. en el lado noreste de la ciudad, fuera de Fanoe Rd.

La Comunidad incluye 768 acres con 3.498 viviendas de todos los tamaños y niveles de precio. El proyecto tardará varios años en completarse, la primera fase incluye 400 viviendas.

El desarrollador y la ciudad esperan que la construcción del proyecto comience en la primavera de 2026.



La Comunidad de Vista Lucia incluirá varios tipos de viviendas, como Apartamentos, Casas Adosadas y Viviendas Unifamiliares. También incluirá Nuevas Escuelas, Grandes Parques y Espacios Abiertos, una Estación de Bomberos, Nuevos Senderos y Caminos a Parques y Nuevas Zonas Comerciales.

VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT FOR MST'S MEASURE Q OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

On November 4, 2014, the voters of Monterey County approved the first-ever countywide sales tax measure for public transit. In July 2015, the Monterey-Salinas Transit Local Transit Funding for Senior Citizens, Veterans and People with Disabilities sales tax, otherwise known as Measure Q, began to raise approximately \$8 million per year to be used solely for services and equipment that support transportation programs for veterans, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities. An oversight committee was created in April 2015 to review and report on the revenue and expenditure of funds from the tax.

Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) is seeking enthusiastic volunteers to apply as a member of the oversight committee to represent the following:

- The County of Monterey, to include a representative from an unincorporated area of Monterey County.
- The Seaside- Marina-Monterey urbanized area to include a representative from among the cities of Carmel-by-the-Sea, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Seaside, Del Rey Oaks, Sand City, and Marina.
- The non-urbanized areas to include a representative from among the cities of Gonzales, Greenfield, Soledad, and King City.

START NOW. It's never too late or too early to incorporate healthy habits.



BREAK A SWEAT

Engage in regular cardiovascular exercise that elevates heart rate and increases blood flow. Studies have found that physical activity reduces risk of cognitive decline.



HIT THE BOOKS

Formal education will help reduce risk of cognitive decline and dementia. Take a class at a local college, community center or online.



BUTT OUT

Smoking increases risk of cognitive decline. Quitting smoking can reduce risk to levels comparable to those who have not smoked.



FOLLOW YOUR HEART

Risk factors for cardiovascular disease and stroke – obesity, high blood pressure and diabetes – negatively impact your cognitive health.



STUMP YOURSELF

Challenge your mind. Build a piece of furniture. Play games of strategy, like bridge.

Growing evidence indicates that people can reduce their risk of cognitive decline by adopting key lifestyle habits. When possible, combine these habits to achieve maximum benefit for the brain and body.

HEADS UP!
