City of Gonzales Awarded Project of the Year Award for Construction of an Emergency Disposal Pond In December, the City had to build an emergency disposal pond at the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant. It was needed right away due to slow percolation from high groundwater, large amounts of agwash water coming from the Industrial Business Park and rainwater. The project was authorized on December 11th and the contractor (Swift Tectonics) quickly mobilized on it. They worked 10-hour days to have it completed by December 24th.

The project was presented with the **Project** of the Year Award by the Monterey Bay Chapter of the American Public Works Association at their awards ceremony on February 6th.
