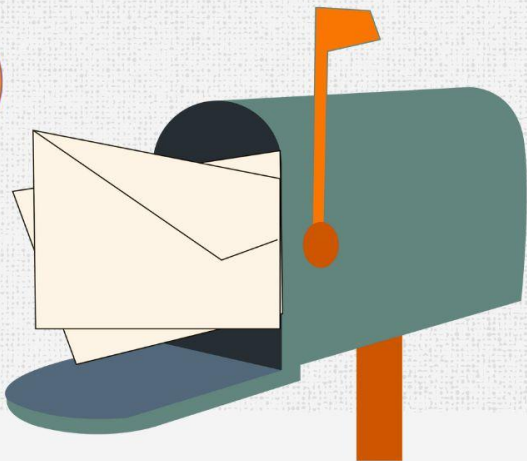


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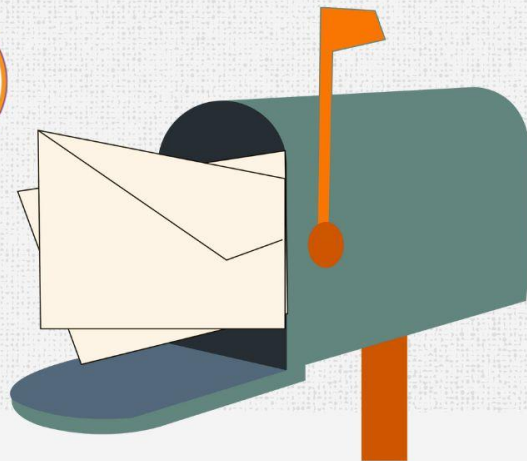

CITY UPDATE

On Tuesday, September 2nd the Gonzales City Council approved the Vista Lucia Project unanimously.

The Vista Lucia Project will provide guidance for the development of up to 3,498 residential units, comprised of single family and multi-family units, along with two commercial mixed-use centers, three school sites, and recreational facilities that will include parks, play fields, trails, plazas, community gardens, and neighborhood squares- all over a period of 20-30 years.

The City is committed to keeping residents informed as we move into the next step in the annexation process.

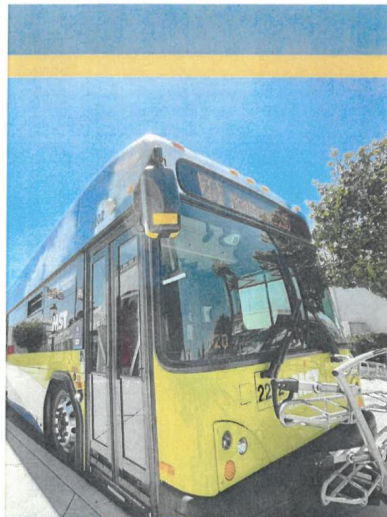

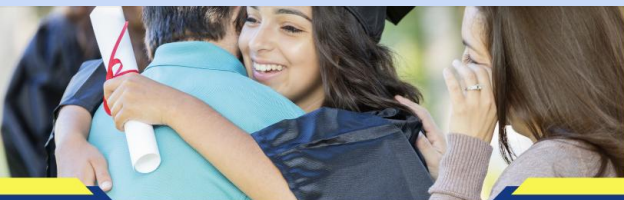

Silver Star Resource Center (SSRC) is a multiagency collaborative of prevention and early intervention services designed to promote positive youth developments by reducing risk factors that lead to gang involvement and delinquency of youth in Monterey County ages 6-21.

The collaborative provides a "ONE-STOP" location of caring connection for youth and family services. SSRC employs an innovative, multi-agency approach that combines probation supervision, educational, vocational and job training, counseling and mediation services, anger management, truancy abatement, mentoring outreach to the community, substance abuse programs an family support service to at-risk or gang involved youth.

VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT FOR MST'S MEASURE Q OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

On November 4, 2014, the voters of Monterey County approved the first-ever countywide sales tax measure for public transit. In July 2015, the Monterey-Salinas Transit Local Transit Funding for Senior Citizens, Veterans and People with Disabilities sales tax, otherwise known as Measure Q, began to raise approximately \$8 million per year to be used solely for services and equipment that support transportation programs for veterans, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities. An oversight committee was created in April 2015 to review and report on the revenue and expenditure of funds from the tax.

Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) is seeking enthusiastic volunteers to apply as a member of the oversight committee to represent the following:

- The County of Monterey, to include a representative from an unincorporated area of Monterey County.
- The Seaside- Marina-Monterey urbanized area to include a representative from among the cities of Carmel-by-the-Sea, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Seaside, Del Rey Oaks, Sand City, and Marina.
- The non-urbanized areas to include a representative from among the cities of Gonzales, Greenfield, Soledad, and King City.
